- SET 1: REGULAR VERBS**
Word: jump
Rule: (Blank)
- SET 2: VERBS WITH SILENT E**
Word: love
Rule: If the verb ends with a silent e, drop the e before adding -ing or -ed
- SET 3: -ES ENDINGS**
Word: wash
Rule: Add -es if the verb ends in: sh, ch, s, x, or z
- SET 4: Y TO I ENDINGS**
Word: cry
Rule: If the verb ends in a consonant + y, drop the y and change to i before adding -es or -ed
- SET 5: PLURAL NOUNS WITH F**
Word: leaf
Rule: If a noun ends in f, drop the f and add -es
- SET 6: PLURAL NOUNS WITH S**
Word: nice
Rule: If the adjective ends with a silent e, drop the e before adding -er or -est
- SET 7: PLURAL NOUNS WITH Y**
Word: fly
Rule: If a noun ends in a consonant + y, drop the y and add i before adding -es
- SET 8: PLURAL NOUNS WITH -ES**
Word: tiny
Rule: If the adjective ends with a consonant + y, drop the y and add i before adding -er or -est
- SET 9: DOUBLE CONSONANTS**
Word: pat
Rule: If a one syllable word ends with a vowel + consonant, double the final consonant before adding -ed or -ing
- SET 10: REGULAR PLURAL NOUNS**
Word: car
Rule: Add -s to most nouns to make them plural (more than one).
- SET 11: PLURAL NOUNS WITH -ES**
Word: box
Rule: If a noun ends in sh, ch, s, x, or z, add -es to make it plural.
- SET 12: REGULAR COMPARATIVE & SUPERLATIVE ADJECTIVES**
Word: fast
