

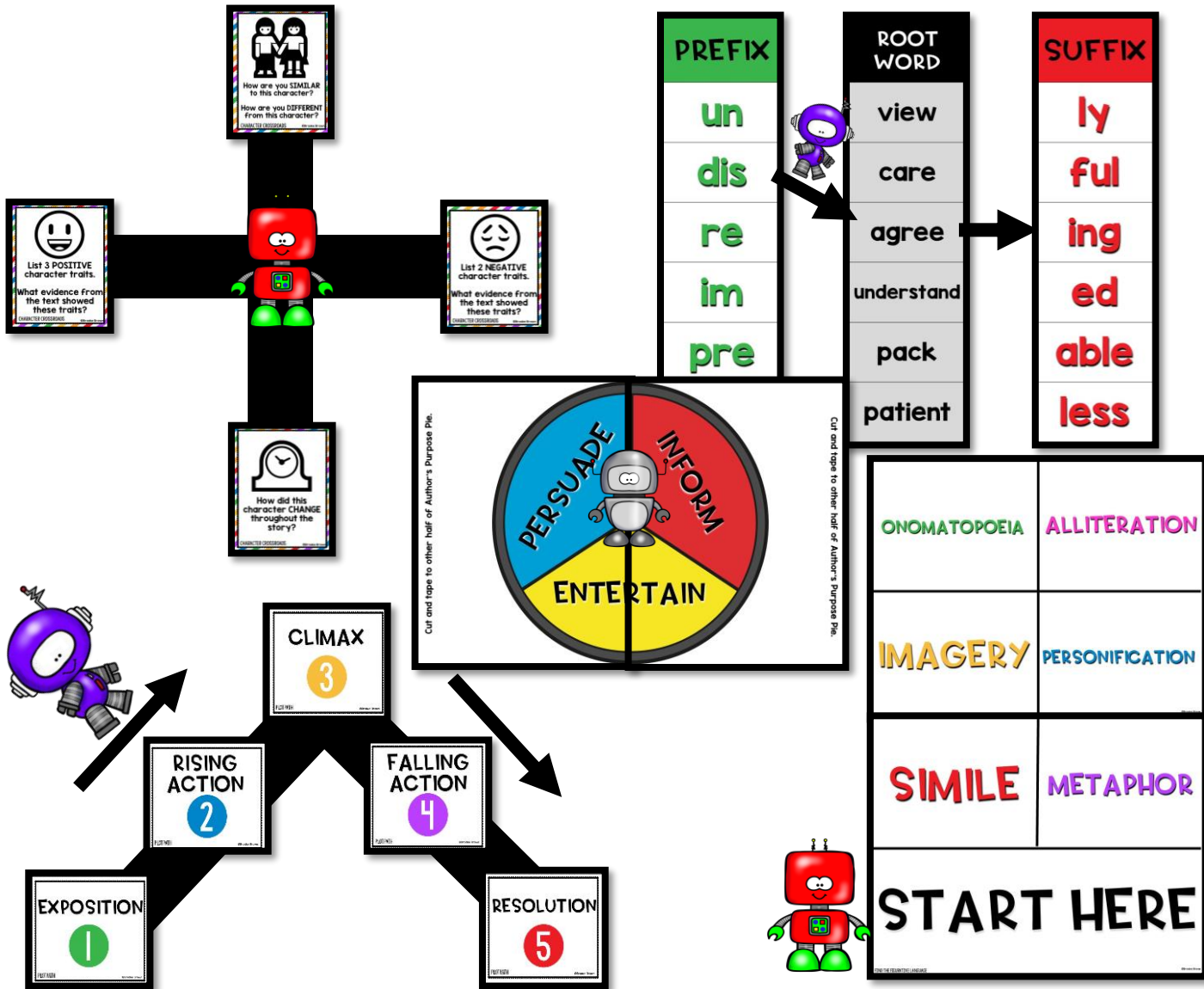

  - Same Game:** A game for identifying synonyms.
  - Find the Figurative Language:** A worksheet for identifying metaphors, similes, etc.
- Other Activities:**
  - Character:** Worksheets for identifying characters and their roles.
  - Exposition:** Worksheets for understanding the beginning of a story.
  - Rising Action:** Worksheets for understanding the middle of a story.
  - Falling Action:** Worksheets for understanding the end of a story.
  - Plot Path:** A worksheet for understanding the sequence of events in a story.
  - Author's Purpose Pie:** A circular diagram for identifying an author's purpose (Persuade, Inform, Entertain).
  - Main Idea Maze:** A maze where students follow the main idea of a text.

- MAIN IDEA MAZE:** A template for writing a main idea, including sections for main idea, detail 1, detail 2, and detail 3.
- FACT FINDER:** A template for finding facts, including sections for main topic, fun fact 1, fun fact 2, and fun fact 3.
- TEXT FEATURE TAGS:** A template for identifying text features, including sections for photograph, heading, caption, diagram, label, bold print, map, timeline, table of contents, and glossary.
- PREFIX AND SUFFIX MATCH UP:** Two templates for matching prefixes and suffixes with words.
