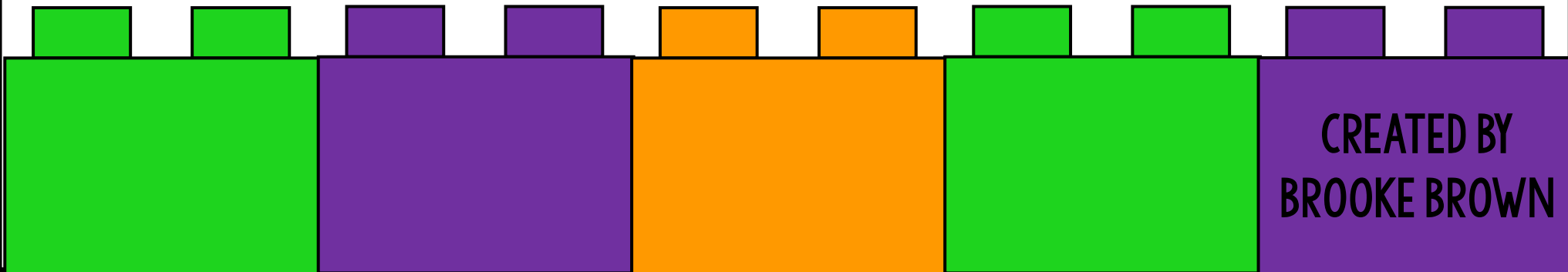

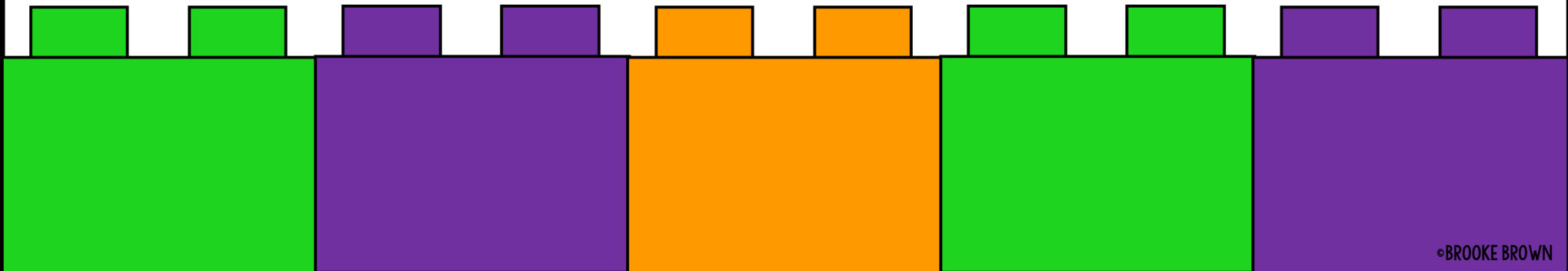

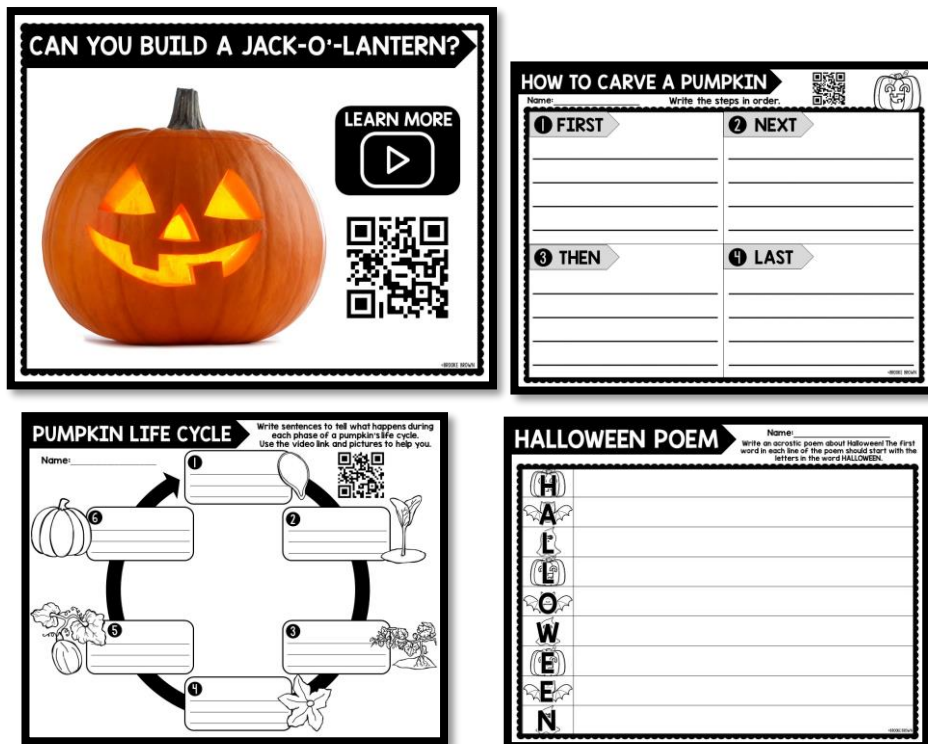


HOW TO USE

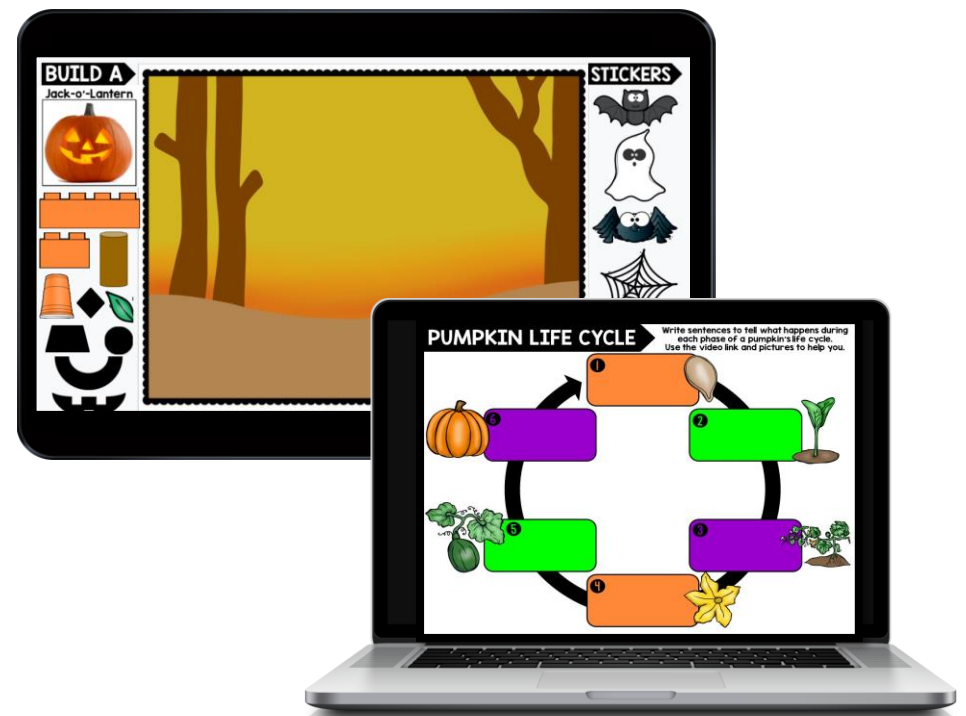
STEM Bins® Build and Write activities combine simple, interactive engineering tasks with engaging writing prompts for first through third grade.
